
Zebra - Faber-Castell - Water Colour Pencils - Albrecht Durer

Work at your own pace. Keep in mind that Sandra is a very experienced artist with 35 plus years developing her skill as an artist. This allows her to be able to complete artworks such as this in a very short time period. **Take your time**. Re-watch and rewind as many times as you like... **above all enjoy**.

Materials:

Paper: Clairefontaine PastelMat. Choose a background you like. Sandra has used SIENNA but you can pick a colour you have or like.

COLOURS: Faber-Castell - Water Colour Pencils - Albrecht Durer.
These are recommended but you may match these to other quality pencils.



To start:

Down load the line drawing and the picture. Transfer your image to your sheet of ClaireFontaine paper using a colour that you can clearly see.

Step 1 (video 01):

With your 270 -warm grey 1 block in the light areas. Next you will use your 175 - Dark Sepia to block in the dark areas. Once these are blocked in, use your damp brush and **pat** it onto the pencil. this will turn the pencil into the liquid form.

Step 2 (video 02):

Use your white and black to add depth to your picture. Dab with brush as per video.
